

## **PET TRAVEL POST BREXIT**

Pets travelling abroad to the EU or Northern Ireland need:

- Microchip
- Rabies vaccination. If first vaccination this must be followed by minimum three week wait
- Export Health Certificate (EHC) – this is valid for 10 days for outward travel, 4 months for returning
- Tapeworm treatment (will be done at same time as EHC) If travelling to:
  - Finland
  - Ireland
  - Malta
  - Northern Ireland
  - Norway

Evidence of Rabies vaccination needs to be presented at the time of completing the EHC – this can be a certificate or old pet passport.

The vet will need to know the first place in Europe that the pet will arrive at (e.g. if travelling to Spain but going via the Channel Tunnel this would be France)

***The EHC is very long and time consuming and can take up to 45 minutes to complete. The charge for this is £ 95***
